There is a reason why people and businesses from all over the world find their way to Novi - the 32-square mile gem in Southeast Michigan is buzzing with activity.

Novi has long been known for its welcoming nature and has created an authentic environment focused on inclusivity and economic growth. Novi's prime location in Southeast Michigan keeps a global supply chain flowing to and from international destinations.

The city sits at the convergence of major interstates and a state freeway. Detroit Metropolitan Wayne County Airport is just 20 minutes away, and nearby rails contribute to Novi's prime logistics network.

With one of the lowest property tax rates in Michigan, Novi presents a competitive platform for attracting and retaining companies. In 2022, the City's taxable value reached \$4.5 billion, defining Novi as one of Oakland County's top cities, based on taxable value.

Its balanced tax base and low debt allows it to remain at the forefront of evolving technology and services, including a top-performing, accredited police department and park system.






Population



Between the 2010 and 2020 Census, Novi was the fastest growing city in Oakland County. The 2020 Census stated Novi's position as a growing and attractive community with a population of 66,243. This represents a 19% increase from 2010. Novi is presently home to prestigious schools, quality residential neighborhoods, a thriving retail and high-tech economy and beautifully preserved natural areas.

Median Household Income






Combined Housing Units Added

The Novi housing market is very competitive. Many homes get multiple offers, with waived contingencies common. The average homes sell for about 2% above list price. In 2022, the average cost per square foot was \$205. The residential market continues to struggle with low inventory, resulting in fewer sales and upward pressure on sale prices.

The decrease in residential construction permit values from 2021 to 2022 is attributed to the shortage of lots available in Novi. There were 27 new home issues and 272 multifamily units for a total of 299 new dwelling units in 2022.

Multifamily permits are classified under commercial construction. One large multifamily project, Innova Apartments, which was approved in 2022, accounts for 88 percent of the increase in commercial construction values from 2021 to 2022.




Novi Employment Sector 2022



Number of Jobs





Novi Business Prosperity & Diversity

Today, over 3,000 businesses are located in Novi, including more than 130 foreign-owned firms from 20+ different countries. The City's ability to embrace diversity draws international companies and families to the area, empowering business and community life. With over 3,000 Japanese residents, Novi is home to the largest Japanese population in Michigan. Novi and Oakland County jointly support long-held plans to develop the \$50 million Sakura Novi mixed use development. In 2018, a developer purchased 10 acres from the City for \$3.15 million. Sakura Novi is expected to break ground later in 2023.








City of Novi Investment in Future

The City remains committed to improving its current infrastructure and bringing new assets to its residents. The Fiscal Year 2023 capital improvement program includes over \$22 million in investment. Significant improvements include \$9.9 million in roads, \$400,000 in sidewalks and pathways, \$6.4 million for storm sewer and water distribution, and \$3.8 million for building and property improvements, equipment and technology.



While construction projects may cause disruptions, the City of Novi takes pride in partnering with the business community in many ways, including ensuring access remains maintained for employees and customers and relaxing sign ordinances in times of need.

Economic Development Corporation (EDC)

The Economic Development Corporation of the City of Novi consists of nine members who meet quarterly to provide oversight and guidance on the City's economic development activities. The EDC is responsible for the disbursement of funds from the Economic Development Fund. The EDC is a resource for reviewing requests for Industrial Revenue Bonds and for other economic development initiatives, as needed.
